2023 HIGHLIGHTS

ART CLASSES

Our girls and teenagers continued to develop their creativity through our art classes. These classes were one of the few volunteer programs we had in 2023.

With the support and experience of our magnificent volunteers, it was through this project that we were able to improve the lives of the girls and teens, increasing their creativity, sensitivity and self-esteem.





PADDLE TENNIS LESSONS



Being the mission of St. Paul's Anglican Church of San Miguel de Allende to encourage paddle sports among the youth and adults in the community, helping them to find greater joy and dignity in their personal lives; enhancing their physical and

emotional development through sports, through its "Clases de a Peso" (Classes for a Pesos) program, St. Paul's Church sponsored our girls and teenagers to take paddle tennis classes.

Paddle tennis is a sport that helps to improve coordination throughout the body, since you have to combine leg movements with arm movements. One of the great benefits of paddle tennis for children and teens is that it will greatly improve their balance and speed of movement.

The girls continued to get physically active with zumba classes.

CROCHET KNITTING WORKSHOP

Another of the few volunteer programs we had in 2023 was the Crochet Knitting workshop.



Thanks to the wonderful volunteers, our girls not only had the opportunity to create, but it also helped them as relaxation therapy, since knitting is an activity that helps with stress and anxiety.

QUALITY

The staff of Casa Hogar Santa Julia Don Bosco is constantly being strengthened by taking courses and workshops offered by governmental and private agencies.

OPERATIVE

- 1.- We reinforced in the girls and teenagers the learning of good habits and values, especially "respect for one another".
- 2.- We were able to achieve constancy in their education (preschool, elementary, middle school, and high school).
- 3.- We have achieved an optimized comprehensive development (nutrition, education, physical activation, among others).





2023 began by providing care to 23 girls and teenagers

Admissions

- <u>9</u> (1st Quarter)
- <u>1</u> (2nd Quarter)
- <u>1</u> (3rd Quarter)
- <u>1</u> (4th Quarter)

Releases

- 8 girls were reintegrated with their birth family
- <u>1</u> adoption
- 11 were referred to other institutions

The following services were provided:

- Total of <u>100</u> medical services (Treatments) and 24 vaccinations
- Total of <u>51</u> dental services (Treatments)
- Total of <u>24</u> ophthalmological services (Treatments)
- Total of <u>588</u> psychological services (Treatments)
- Total of <u>12</u> nutritional services (Treatments)

A total <u>35</u> of girls and teenagers were in Residential Care* in 2023 (No. of girls starting 2023 + No. of Admissions).

2023 ended with 15 girls and teenagers in residential care.

*Residential Care: It is "exercised in any non-family collective environment, such as safe places for emergency care, transit centers in emergency cases and all other short and long term residential care centers, including functional homes"... (Diccionario básico para la perspectiva de los derechos de los Niños, Niñas y Adolescentes en el Estado de Guanajuato).

The objective of this workshop was to promote financial education by providing the teenage girls with tools, knowledge and basic skills in money management; through planning and making responsible financial decisions, fostering an entrepreneurial spirit, encouraging confidence and self-esteem.
